Opening

Motion: (Eric Garceau- Sheri Cameron) to accept the agenda. Carried.

Overview of the budget

Philip Massarelli gave an overview of the budget. He noted that we are not passing the budget today as that will happen at the annual meeting March 12.

He also noted that our number one expense is employment expenses.

Projects

The congregation was presented with 5 possible projects to add to the budget.

1. Replacing the brown tables (\$1,750 for 10 tables)

Some churches will be contacted if they are closing see if there is a possibility of donations.

2. Replacing the wooden chairs (\$560)

Kim Wildenmann suggested getting rid of all the wooden chairs, however congregational approval would be required.

3. Repairing the brick work (\$50,000)

\$11,850 would be required immediately for essential work on the 7th avenue side of the church

4. install big screen tv or replace sanctuary projector (\$3,000)

Mikayla presented her proposal to either replace the projector in the Sanctuary which is old and doesn't have a very high quality image or replace it with a large tv.

5. Converting from florescent to led lighting (\$1,500)

To upgrade our sanctuary lighting and be able to dim the lights. We are just replacing the light bulbs not the light fixtures.

Votes were taken to determine which projects would be added to the budget.

- 2. Replacing the wooden chairs: (\$560.00) Carried
- 3. a Repair the broken bricks full work (\$50,000.00) not approved
